

The DECC St. Louis is attending the Southern Illinois University (SIU) Edwardsville Career Fest '02 on 2 October 2002 to recruit students for our Student Career Experience Program (SCEP) and our Outstanding Scholars Program (OSP).

The DISA SCEP targets second semester Sophomores, Juniors and first semester Seniors enrolled in a four-year program that leads to a degree in Information Technology, Management Information Systems, Computer Science or other related fields. The students must maintain a GPA of 2.0 or better, be a US citizen and be able to obtain and retain a Security Clearance.

Acceptance into the program offers full exposure to real life IT work experiences and a benefits package that includes the earning of annual and sick leave. Successful completion of the SCEP program often leads to non-competitive conversion to a GS-2210-5 or GS-7 IT intern position with promotion potential (Full Performance Level) to the GS-12 level.

The DISA OSP is for students who have graduated with a four-year degree in the areas of Information Technology, Management Information Systems, Computer Science or other directly related field. The student must have graduated with a GPA of 3.45 or better for all their undergraduate course work at all institutions attended OR have graduated in the upper 10% of their class. They must also be US citizens and be able to obtain and retain a Security Clearance. This authority allows appointment at the GS-7 level with a Full Performance Level of GS-12.
